XIII. NUMBER OF ROUNDS

Maximum round: 8 rounds

Validation: Minimum one round has to be completed to validate the competition.

XIV. SCORING

Method:

- Flying order – as per S7C
- Video evidence – Yes (see S7C 3.6)
- AMDs used: made in Indonesia
- Launch interval: 30 seconds maximum and can be adjusted depending on the conditions at the time by Launch Marshall
- Radius of the automatic measuring device field: 22 cm. (see S7C 4.3)
- Radius of the measuring field: 500 cm. (see S7C 4.4.1)
- Radius of target area (within which pilots must not fall): 10m.
- Number of rounds and number of minimum rounds: see S7C 5.1

1. Individual score:

According to S7C 5.4.3

2. Team Score:

Pilots cannot change team during season. Number of pilots in team is four (4) and the three (3) best results will be calculated for the team score per round.

Teams can nominate more pilots than four (4), but before the competition starts, the team leader must inform the organisers which four (4) pilots will be in the team for that event.

Rest will be competed like individual

3. Result publishing

As soon as is practical after the end of round, the recorder will post the scores from the round (with the posting date and time clearly identified and labelled 'Provisional') on the main briefing board. If provisional scores are posted more than 2 hours after sunset and before 06.00am the next day, then the deadline for a complaint is 08.00am. For the last competition round, complaints must be submitted within one hour after the publication of the provisional results (S7C 7.7.1).

XV. WIND LIMITATIONS

Maximum wind speed limit: 6 m/s

XVI. EQUIPMENT REQUIREMENTS General

All equipment must comply with S7C chapter 8. Equipment will be checked during the registration process by the Inspection committee (4 person)

Contest numbers

The pilot contest numbers supplied by the organizers must be visible and placed on leg of pilot and helmet, as specified at registration.

Radios

The organizer requires pilots to carry a radio able to receive and transmit on the specified safety frequency.

- The radio frequency is 149.290 Mhz
- Voice activated microphones (VOX operated) are strictly forbidden.

XVII. SAFETY COMMITTEE

The Safety Committee will include: Meet Director (or Deputy), Launch Marshal (or Deputy), a senior member of Judging Team, and a minimum of two experienced pilots (One local and one foreign pilot who must be competitors)

XVIII. VIDEO EVIDENCE

Organizer will provide video recording on the landing. In the case where amateur video evidence is available when an official complaint is made, the Chief Judge reserves the right to choose whether and when to view that video evidence. The decision will be made in a case-by-case basis. Further information on the policy on video evidence will be provided at the first pilot briefing.

A lack of video evidence is not valid reason to award a re-launch

XIX. PENALTIES

In accordance with Section 7 and 7C

XX. COMPLAINTS AND PROTESTS

If the complainant is not satisfied with the outcome, the team leader may make a protest in writing to the Meet Director or his deputy. The time limit for protests is 2 hours (1 hour after last round) after notice of the result of the complaint. The protest fee is Rp 500.000 It will be returned if the protest is upheld.

Competitors MUST bring 2 national flags. They should be approximately 150 x 225cm in size such that they look good in a row rather than some large and some small.
